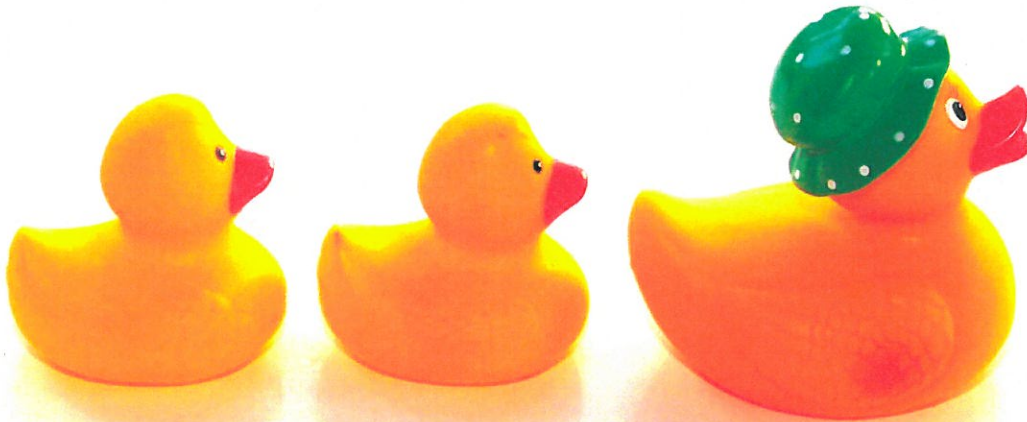


Welcome to the **RUBBER DUCKY CLUB!**

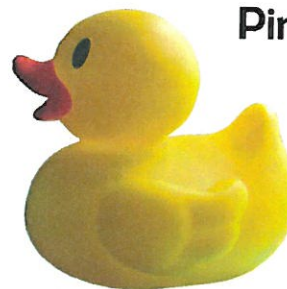
After completing the first sheet of activities, participants will receive a rubber ducky. After completing the second sheet, participants will receive a board book.

Talking



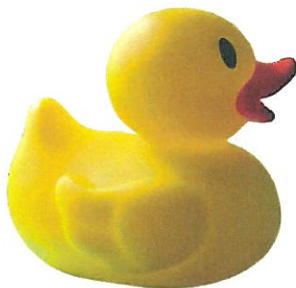
Draw letters in the sand!

Let your child turn the pages of a book while you read together!

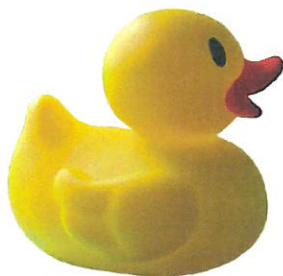

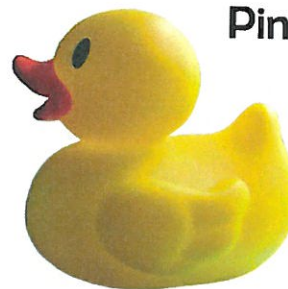


Make letters with play dough!

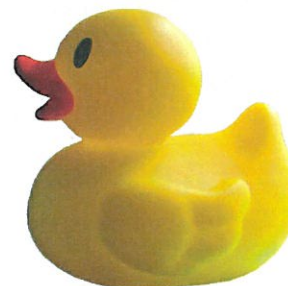
